Use of ICT

Requests for absence and school attendance

This has been in the news again recently. We are very grateful to you for ensuring that your children are in school with good attendance and on time. Being in school by 8.45am really does make a big difference to the children, it ensures that they have time to settle to learning quickly. We do find that when children are late they are often unsettled as they have missed either the first learning input or activity and are consequently in a state of catch up. The recent court ruling seems to have confirmed that non-medical absence can only be authorised in very exceptional circumstances.

Parking

Once again some concerns have been raised by neighbours and parents about the safety and consideration of parking outside the school. Please do ensure that you are parking safely outside of the school.

However, it would be really helpful if you could time the dosage to be taken outside of school hours. Speaking to the school nurse with things like antibiotics this is often possible if one dose is at 8.30am and the next is at 3.30pm or there about.

End of the school day arrangements

An increasing number of children are being collected after 3.15pm, where children are being collected late we will be putting them into the afterschool club for which there will be a charge. We understand that there are sometimes unavoidable incidents and if this is the case please let us know as soon as you can.
