Contact details

This has to be completed before your child starts with us, we require 2 points of contact so that in the event of a need to contact a carer we can do so quickly. Please see our Privacy Notice on our website for details on Data Protection (GDPR)

Hot meals

All children in reception, year 1 and year 2 are entitled to a free school meal. Our meals are provided by Local Food links. All food orders must be completed online. Details will follow shortly as the company are organising their

Milk

Children below the age of 5 are entitled to free milk in school, once your child has turned 5 then milk needs to be paid for.

Bus arrangements

Many of our children use Dorset Transport, all children are greeted by a member of staff on arrival at school. At the end of the day a member of staff takes all the children to the bus and ensures that seatbelts are done up etc. If your child will be using the school bus please ensure that the form is completed and that the office is informed as soon as possible of any changes.

Requirements for afternoons in schools

From 14th September (please note this is a change from our original letter) your child is welcome to stay for the whole of the school day, please ensure that you have completed the form to ensure we are informed as to who will be with each afternoon. This can be reviewed and changed regularly.
