. Christmas

I know it is early to mention this but our new parents may find it useful to know the ticketing arrangements for the Christmas Production. There will be 2 evening productions that will be in our school hall, this does impose limits on numbers to comply with all health and safety regulations. This means that each family will be able to apply for 2 tickets only. This ensures that every child will have 2 family members coming to see them perform. Tickets are not available yet but when they are they will be allocated through the parent evening system. When considering who in your family will be attending we ask that no child under school age attends an evening performance. The Pre School children will be invited to watch the dress rehearsal during the school day, there may be limited availability for other family members for this performance.

Parking and the School Carpark

I met recently with our Police Community Support Officer to discuss parking. Please do continue to ensure that you park with consideration for our neighbours and the safety of the children. There is ALWAYS space in the Rec carpark for you.

Please do not use the school carpark without prior arrangement with the school. Due to the school buses there is not the space for parent cars. It is not safe to use the carpark as a walking route either, please use the pedestrian gate. It is really important that all adults model the behaviours we want for the children on all occasions.

Then grit your teeth and let them do it! Where they get it wrong let them live with the consequences and don't let big sisters step into the parent role. Remember short term pain for long term dain!
