Firstly, on 2nd March we are having an off timetable day where we will mix the age groups up into house teams and undertake a range of activities that explore different genres of books and writing.

This will be followed by our 'Books at Bedtime' which is one of my favourite evenings at school. Books at Bedtime will be from 5.15pm to 6.15pm this year. The children should meet in the hall in their pyjamas ready for a good evening of stories with the school staff.

On Friday 3rd March the children are invited to celebrate their favourite books or literary characters with us. They may choose to dress as their favourite character, bring in their favourite book or a prop from a well loved story. Please do note that there is no compulsion to dress up and all children will have the chance to celebrate and share their favourite literature with their class.

Healthy Eating

This ½ term in our Personal, Social and Health Education lessons the theme is 'Healthy Me.' This will involve looking at the reasons for and benefits of an active lifestyle and a balanced diet.

Within lessons, classes will be looking at diet and food groups etc. A way in which school and home can work together would be for you to involve your child in planning their fruit snacks and packed lunches, if they aren't having a hot meal. Getting the children to focus evaluating how their lunch fits with a balanced diet and what they need to include will have more impact than the lessons on their own and will help to establish habits that last into adult hood. Your child will have brought home a pack from 'Change 4 Life' to share with you.
